POSITION OVERVIEW

The Radiology Technologist/Scrub Tech is responsible for performing diagnostic imaging examinations and ensuring high-quality imaging while prioritizing patient care and safety. They work closely with physicians and healthcare professionals to capture accurate images for diagnosing medical conditions.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Prepare patients for imaging procedures, explaining the process and ensuring their comfort and safety.
- Operate and maintain radiology equipment, ensuring proper functionality and calibration.
- Position patients accurately to achieve optimal image quality while adhering to safety protocols.
- Utilize radiation safety measures and protective equipment to minimize exposure to patients and staff.
- Maintain accurate patient records and update the Radiology Information System (RIS) or Picture Archiving and Communication System (PACS).
- Positioning also entails scrubbing vascular access procedures for dialysis procedures
- Maintain sterile field and provide support during pre- and post-procedure.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Prior experience in diagnostic imaging preferred.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills to interact with patients and team members
- Commitment to patient care, confidentiality, and safety standards.



- Requires physical stamina for standing for extended periods and moving patients
- Work may involve exposure to radiation, so adherence to safety protocols is critical.
- Professional, courteous, calm and pleasant communication style
- Ability to handle multiple tasks coming from doctors, patients and coworkers
- Ability to maintain a organized, calm and courteous demeanor under pressure
- Ability to problem-solve and follow up to resolve an issue to find information
- Basic computer skills are required

- Must be fully vaccinated at the time of hire
